Romans 10:17

Proverbs 28:13

13 He who conceals his transgressions will not prosper, But he who confesses and forsakes them will find compassion.

NOT BY WORKS

Romans 4:4-5

4 Now to the one who works, his wage is not reckoned as a favor, but as what is due.5 But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is reckoned as righteousness,.

NOT BY WORKS

Ephesians 2:8-9

8 For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God;9 not as a result of works, that no one should boast.

MUST REPENT

22 "Therefore repent of this wickedness of yours, and pray the Lord that if possible, the intention of your heart may be forgiven you.

MUST RECEIVE

John 1:12

12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name,

MUST REPENT

Acts 26:20

20 but kept declaring both to those of Damascus first, and also at Jerusalem and then throughout all the region of Judea, and even to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, performing deeds appropriate to repentance.

MUST RECEIVE

John 3:36

36 "He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

MUST RECEIVE

Revelation 3:20

20 'Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him, and will dine with him, and he with Me.

John 10:27-28

Psalms 119:9-11

THE WORD OF GOD - READ IT

Revelation 1:3

3 Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of the prophecy, and heed the things which are written in it; for the time is near.

THE WORD OF GOD - STUDY IT

2 Timothy 2:15

15 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, handling accurately the word of truth.

THE WORD OF GOD - MEDITATE ON IT

Joshua 1:8

8 "This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success.

THE WORD OF GOD - OBEY IT

James 4:17

17 Therefore, to one who knows the right thing to do, and does not do it, to him it is sin.

PRAYER

Matthew 21:22

PRAYER

Philippians 4:6-7

6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.⁷ And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, shall guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

1 John 3:22

42 And they were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

FELLOWSHIP

Hebrews 10:25

25 not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more, as you see the day drawing near.

SURRENDER (DEDICATION)

Romans 6:12-13

12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body that you should obey its lusts,¹³ and do not go on presenting the members of your body to sin as instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

FELLOWSHIP

1 John 1:3

3 what we have seen and heard we proclaim to you also, that you also may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father, and with His Son Jesus Christ.

SURRENDER (DEDICATION)

Romans 12:1-2

1 I urge you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.² And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

SURRENDER (DEDICATION)

1 Corinthians 10:31

31 Whether, then, you eat or drink or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.
