Chapter 13: Babylon

Chapter 13 Babylon

1] [Chapters 13 & 14. Cf. Jer 50 & 51.] [100yearsbeforetheBabylonianEmpire!]

Babylon's rise is revealed in Chapter 39; 2 Kgs 20:12-19. Symbol of the Enemy of God: Gen 11:9 - Rev 14:8. "Burden" (massa): a prophecy of impending judgment. Since it describes a plurality of kingdoms (v.4) attacking Babylon, including the Medes (v.17), many assume it refers to fulfilled history (539 B.C., etc.); however, careful analysis of the passage implies that this predicted destruction is yet to happen. [See The Mystery of Babylon for fuller treatment.]

4] Note kingdoms (plural).

5] Includes the Medes (v.17). The scope of the language seems to go far beyond the conquest of the Medes and Persians in 539 B.C. (which occurred without a battle and does not fit the detail).

6] "Day of the Lord": final judgment upon the earth (Cf. v.9).

Almighty (Shaddai): rare use by prophets: Joel 1:15-2:1; Ezek 1:24; 10:5; here.

8] "Woman that travaileth": Isa 21:3; Jer 31:8; Ps 48:6; 1Thess 5:3.

9] Land desolate: cf. v.5.

10] Isa24:21-23;Ezek32:7;Joel2:10,31;3:15;Mt24:39;Mk13:24;Lk21:25.

Constellations, ("orions") et al., worshipped by Nimrod and his tower to the heavens (Bab-El). (Cf. Job 9:9; 38:31; Amos 5:8.)

11] Punish the world: scope broader than just 539B.C.

Pride of Assyria: Isa 10:7-11; of Moab: Isa 16:6; Ultimate: Isa 14:12ff.

13] Isa24:18-20;Jer4:24;Joel3:16;Hag2:6,7;Mt24:29;Heb12:25-29;Zech 14:4,5; 2 Pet 3:10; Rev 6:9-17; 20:11. Every man for himself. Jer 50:16; 51:9.

17] Medes: in Isaiah's day, were allies of Babylon against Assyria! They, allied with the Persians were to conquer Babylon in 539 B.C. They are known as the Kurds,

presently hostile towards Iraq. Also mentioned in Jer 51:11; 2 Kgs 17:6.

18] Bow was chief weapon. Herodotus: "Every youth was to learn to ride, draw a bow, and speak the truth." ["Bows" to dash in pieces? Key-sheth refer to "launchers?"]

19] Chaldeans = southern part of the country. Like Sodom and Gomorrah? Hasn't happened yet.

20] Isa 47:1; Rev 18:7. When Koldewey, the German archaeologist, excavated in the 19th century, he was able to hire local residents. Saddam Hussein has spent hundreds of millions over the past 20 years rebuilding the key buildings. [Shown on aeronautical charts as "numerous large buildings" 14 miles SE of Al Hillah, about 62 miles S of Baghdad. Not a military target in the Persian Gulf War.]

21] hao'och, doleful creatures: howling animal; jackal; hyena.

hn:[]y ya'anah: an unclean bird; owl, ostrich, literally translated as "daughters of the owl"; perhaps an extinct bird, exact meaning unknown. ry[vl ,: sa'iy: 59X: kid28, goat24, devil2, satyr2, hairy2, rough1. Hairy; he-goat, buck; as sacrificial animal; satyr, may refer to a demon possessed goat like the swine of Gadara (Mt 8:30-32). Terms also used of demons (Lev 17:7; 2 Chr 11:15).

22] Wildbeasts: howling creatures. Coastlands: islands.

Cry: shriek.

Dragons: jackals.

Cf Jer 51:33.

There are 19 indisputable uses of “the Day of the Lord” in the Old Testament and 4 in the New Testament (Acts 2:20; 2 Thess. 2:2; 2 Pet. 3:10). The Old Testament prophets used “Day of the Lord” to describe near historical judgments (Is. 13:6–22; Ezek. 30:2–19; Joel 1:15; 3:14; Amos 5:18–20; Zeph. 1:14–18) or far eschatological divine judgments (Joel 2:30–32; Zech. 14:1; Mal. 4:1,5). Six times it is referred to as the “day of doom” and 4 times as the “day of vengeance.” The New Testament calls it a day of “wrath,” a day of “visitation,” and the “Great Day of God Almighty” (Rev. 16:14). These are terrifying judgments from God (Joel 2:30,31; 2 Thess. 1:7–10) for the overwhelming sinfulness of the world.

Each of these disasters is only a preview, we understand, of the devastating fire of God, when He will consume everything left at the end of the thousand years, before He sets up the new heaven and the new earth.


While all the implications of that horrible scene is being digested by our minds, note the 5th trumpet in Rev. 9:1.

John sees an angelic creature falling like a burning meteor to earth with a key.

What a key he holds.

This is probably Lucifer, the Devil who is allowed to let out all the imprisoned terrorist-like demons, locked up by God over thousands of years.

All the bound up, out-of-control demons that have been imprisoned down there for centuries gush out of the prison pit in verse 2, like: "Smoke out of the pit, like the smoke of a furnace and the sun and the air darkened by reason of the smoke of the pit."





Most dispensational Bible teachers, who interpret the Bible primarily as literal so they see a clear difference between Israel and the Church: would hold to something like these seven simple events in Revelation.

God Gives the Specific Details on the End of the World

Isaiah 13:6-22; Matthew 24:8, 33-34
expanded into Revelation 6-19

Please open with me to Matthew 24.

The disciples ask Jesus a question that interests all of us, I'm so glad they did. Follow along as they ask in Matthew 24:3, and as Jesus answers them in verse 8 and 33. This week I was examining just how much God has left for us to know about the future.

I hold in my hand the ONE Book that God wrote—the Bible.

This one book, made up of 66 books has a total of 31,103 verses.

Of all the verses in the Bible 8,352 verse are prophetic or spoke to future events. All Biblical predictions about the future in these thousands verses can be grouped into 737 different predictions.

Of these 8,352 verses, 6,312 (or 522 different predictions) have already happened to the letter, JUST LIKE God's Word said they would.

That leaves just about 2,040 verses with 215 specific predictions from God about the end of the world that are in process of being fulfilled.

So, the Bible contains many specific events that would signal the end of days for life on planet earth as it has been for the past several thousand years.

Each of the prophetic signs Christ and His apostles gave are specific and not vague.

Jesus explained to us in Matthew 24, verses 8 and 33-34—that these events would begin at the same time, run concurrently, and crescendo like the pains of a woman giving birth—the closer we get to His Second coming.

Matthew 24:8, 33-34 All these are the **beginning** of sorrows. 33 So you also, when you see all these things, know that **it is near—at the doors!**
34 Assuredly, I say to you, **this generation** will by no means pass away till all these things take place.

The list of Biblical Signs of Christ's Return will not actually be full blown until the Tribulation time.
Each of the signs of Christ's Return He said--are trends.

These trends are speeding up—the last seconds of the countdown clock of Christ's return are clicking down.
Each day the prophetic picture Christ painted grows clearer.

Each of these signs were captured by the apostles and prophets between 2,000 and 3,500 years ago.

Now they are happening in our lifetime!

But, in all of history--ONLY our generation has seen EVERY ONE of these events starting to unfold.

All of the yet to be completed prophecies fit within these seven major events. Probably the most exciting of all are the signs of Christ's Second Coming. There are dozens of them. Jesus described many of them in incredible detail. But here is what I want you to see—Jesus said these signs would not suddenly appear. He said that they would rather become a trend that amplified and strengthened until it became overwhelming like “birth pangs”.

Let me give you just a handful of the precise, clear, specific predictions that Christ's Words in this Book give us. You may be startled. Every one of the signs Christ gave are present in your world today. You are the first generation in all of history to experience these trends, these signs—all at once!

What are some of them? We will actually in the days ahead look at these in detail, but here they are in summary.

The Sign of Global Telecommunication & Television


Revelation 11:9-10 Then those from the peoples, tribes, tongues, and nations **will see their dead bodies** three-and-a-half days, and not allow their dead bodies to be put into graves. 10 And **those who dwell on the earth** will rejoice over them, make merry, and send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth.

God's Word explicitly declares that mankind will be able to see and hear globally. When the world's fastest known means of travel was the speed of a horse—God says the whole world will see an event and all at the same time, celebrate that event! Truly global communication was foreseen.

This past summer I was standing in the Med on the foundation of Herod's Palace. I pulled out my phone, poked a button and began narrating what I was seeing. Instantly via FB Live the bubbles of dozens of people began to cross my screen. They were watching and listening instantly across the world what I was seeing. That is common.

Revelation 17:8 The beast that you saw was, and is not, and will ascend out of the bottomless pit and go to perdition. And those who dwell on the earth will marvel, whose names are not written in the Book of Life from the foundation of the world, when they see the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.

The Bible predicts that the entire world will "see" certain events unfold. The invention of the television and the deployment of global satellite networks during the 20th century allow news to travel the world at the speed of light for the first time ever. Remember that in the Apostle John's day, news traveled at the speed of horseback.




The Sign of Global Evangelism

Never before our generation was it possible to even know how many people are on this planet. Never was it possible to see the entire planet, let alone reach it all. Today we can send an email anywhere, bounce a radio or television wave anywhere, travel anywhere and most of all—get the Gospel anywhere on this planet. My little website alone has visitors from over 100 different nations on earth. The Christian gospel would be preached as a warning to all nations. Remember what Jesus said? Today, portions or the entire Bible have been translated into over 2,300 languages and dialects covering over 90% of the world's population.

The Sign of Global Pestilences

Matthew 24:7 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, **pestilences**, and earthquakes in various places.

Despite an increase in scientific knowledge, deadly diseases (which the Bible calls "pestilences") would be prevalent. Last month in Michigan at GR's Butterfield Hospital, a man with strep throat barely survived after multiple amputations because the strep traveled into his abdominal cavity. That was not even one of the dreaded, looming, circling ominously close "super-pathogens" waiting on the edges of civilization.

How has travel changed on this planet?

Unless you take a long view, someone living today has no idea how close we are to the end.

The pace of change is staggering.

Think how much the world remained the same from Daniel's day to your great grandfather's day, consider this.

- **3,000 years ago** David hired wooden boats, powered by wind to help bring special wood for the Temple. His son Solomon actually built and operated a fleet of wooden ships that sailed by wind power to carry on extensive trade with Africa, Europe, and parts of Asia. Jonah walked by foot to a port in Israel 2800 years ago and bought a ticket to sail to what is today Spain.
- **2,000 years ago**, the Apostle Paul traveled around the Roman World on mapped out highways by foot, by horse and chariot, or aboard a wooden ship moved along by wind power caught in the sails.
- **500 years ago**, Christopher Columbus embarked for a journey across the Atlantic Ocean in search of a sea route to China. He also probably went to the dock on foot, and boarded a wooden ship not unlike that of David, Solomon, Jonah, and Paul's.
- **200 years ago**, Benjamin Franklin walked to a dock in America to board a wooden sailing vessel for his trip to France.
- **Just over 100 years ago** things began to change abruptly. With the advent of steam man was no longer tied to man power and wind power. With the steamship, the locomotive, the automobile, the airplane and so on—in just one generation the entire world changed!
- **Today** there are routine, scheduled flights of airliners that make the trip from continent to continent in a few hours. Many shall run to and fro, and so we do without hardly a thought. No one in the history of this planet ever traveled like we who are alive today can travel. This is the time of the end of the world!

Daniel 12:4b “But you, Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book until the time of the end; many shall run to and fro, **and knowledge shall increase.**”

Knowledge would increase. We have gone from kilobyte, the megabyte, to gigabyte, to terabytes, to petabytes, to exabytes, to zettabytes, and soon to yottabytes...

Specifically, this is referring to an understanding of Bible prophecy, but also an increase in scientific knowledge is implied.

From wooden boats with sails to MP3's and DVD's that I can watch or create on the personal computer that can also be my phone, television, radio, stereo, workstation, word processor, electronic document file, movie studio, sound studio, telephone answering service, fax machine, copy machine and printer. And a million other things.

The Sign of Global Weather Gone Wild

Luke 21:25-26 “And there will be signs in the sun, in the moon, and in the stars; **and on the earth distress of nations, with perplexity, the sea and the waves roaring**; 26 men’s hearts failing them from fear and the expectation of those things which are coming on the earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken.

Jesus foresaw the time when weather would be so bad that not just a few, but the whole world would be troubled, fearful, and killed by the fear of chaotic weather that would become prevalent.

Jesus foresaw those seas and the waves roaring in the last days, and compared these trends to birth pangs.

Matthew 24:8 All these are the beginning of sorrows.

The Greek word *odynē*, often translated as sorrows in Matthew 24:8, literally means birth pangs. Paul explains to us that all of creation is under the curse of sin.

Romans 8:21 because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

While creation awaits the coming of the Liberator Himself, Christ the Lord—just as when delivery draws near, birth pangs always increase in both intensity and frequency--so the universe itself will travail as the time of delivery draws near.

Romans 8:22 For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now.

Of course chaotic weather has always existed, but there are indications that we are witnessing an increase in strange weather.






